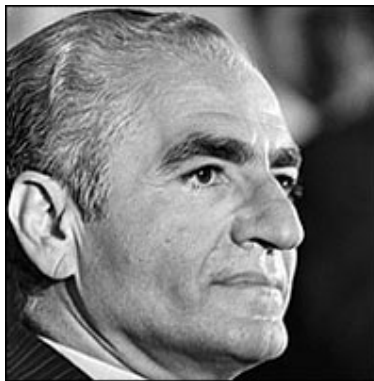




October 26th, Is Iran's Shahyaad day
